And a pony to take you for a ride a ride a ride!



#### Baa baa black sheep


Baa baa black sheep have you any wool?

And one for the little boy who lives




#### **Heads, Shoulders Knees and Toes**

'Good morning'






# Wind the bobbin up!


## **Incy Wincy Spider**
